FROM PHILADELPHIA AND POINTS SOUTH: Take I-476 N to Exit 56 Lehigh Valley. Take U.S. 22 E to Exit for Airport Road South. Keep Right on the exit ramp and merge onto Airport Road heading south. Make a Right on American Parkway (at intersection with light). Make a Left into Coca-Cola Park complex.

FROM NEW YORK CITY AND POINTS NORTH: Take US-19 S/US-1 & 9 S. Take I-78 W. Merge onto PA-33 N via Exit 71 toward US-22 Stroudsburg. Take U.S. 22 W to Exit for Airport Road South. 
2015 Blasters' Training






Congratulations Randy May!

Letter from The Chief

Dear Eastern PA ISEE Newsletter readers,

Beginning on June 30, 2015 the Department will be enforcing \$211.154(f)(5) which states "(W)while loading a blast hole, the following measures shall be followed: Each blast hole shall be logged throughout the leading sic (loading) process to measure the amount and location of explosives placed in the blast hole. The information is to be recorded on the blast report required by \$211.133 (relating to blast report)."

This information is also required to meet the performance standard for blast records in \$211.133(a) which states that "the blaster-in-charge shall prepare a report of each blast to provide the Department with sufficient information to reconstruct the conditions and events surrounding a blast."

This information can be included with the "sketch showing the number of blast holes, burden, spacing, pattern dimensions and point of initiation" required by §211.133(a) (7). Determining the amount of explosives in each hole by logging and recording that information on the blast report along with the requirements to provide "the diameter and depth of blast holes," "the height or length of stemming and deck separation for each hole," and "the types of explosives uses and arrangement in blast holes" are necessary to "provide the Department with sufficient information to reconstruct the conditions and events surrounding a blast."
