Dale Ramsey Memorial Scholarship

The International Society of Explosives Engineers and the entire explosives industry have lost a true leader with the passing of Dale Ramsey this past April. Dale was an industry leader, and highly respected throughout the explosive, mining and construction industries. Known by hundreds of members, he will truly be missed.

Several members and senior industry leaders have expressed an interest in recognizing the great work – the real impact Dale had on so many of us. Collectively we are proposing that we establish a scholarship in Dale's name.

Dale was a tireless advocate for educating the young people who will become our future in the industry. He was the founding advisor for the Penn State student chapter of ISEE, and a frequent speaker in Penn State's classes. He served as a mentor to many students and some faculty over the past twenty-five years. We can think of no better way to honor his memory, and continue his legacy, than to create an endowed scholarship at Penn State

University – a scholarship for a mining engineering student who demonstrates a strong interest in our industry.

Our goal is lofty -- \$50,000 to create a fund in perpetuity—awarding an annual scholarship for future generations of young engineers. To date, we have \$11,000 and are anxious to raise the remaining \$39,000 with your support.

If we are unable to reach the required endowment level, the head of the Mining Engineering Program will make annual awards until the balance is spent.

As all of us in the Society have agreed, we need to educate and recruit the finest engineers, and this is one more way to accomplish that goal. Imagine how thrilling it will be to announce this scholarship at our annual meeting in February and to acknowledge the generous donors who helped make this happen; and imagine how proud Dale would be to know that his lifetime of commitment to this industry and its people will live on through this scholarship. 

The Commercial Vehicle Safety Alliance's (CVSA) 30th annual International Roadcheck will take place June 6-8, 2017. Over a 72-hour period, CVSA-certified commercial motor vehicle inspectors in jurisdictions throughout North America will conduct inspections of commercial motor vehicles and

Each year, International Roadcheck places special emphasis on a category of violations. This year's focus is cargo securement. While checking for compliance with safe cargo securement regulations is always part of roadside inspections,

CVSA is highlighting cargo securement safety this year as a reminder of its importance to highway safety.

CVSA Roadcheck Continued

Inspectors will primarily be conducting the North American Standard Level I Inspection, which is the most thorough roadside inspection. It is a 37-step procedure that includes an examination of both driver operating requirements and vehicle mechanical fitness. **Drivers are required to provide items such as their driver's license, hours-of-service documentation, motor carrier registration and shipping documentation, and inspectors will be checking drivers for seat belt usage and the influence of alcohol and/or drugs.** The vehicle inspection includes checking items such as the brake systems, cargo securement, coupling devices, driveline/driveshaft, exhaust systems, frames, fuel systems, lighting devices (required lamps), steering mechanisms, suspensions, tires, van and open-top trailer bodies, wheels, rims and hubs, windshield wipers, and emergency exits (on buses).


International Roadcheck is the largest targeted enforcement program on commercial motor vehicles in the world, with nearly 17 trucks or buses inspected, on average, every minute in Canada, the United States and Mexico during a 72-hour period. Since its inception, more than 1.5 million roadside inspections have been conducted during International Roadcheck campaigns.

International Roadcheck is a CVSA program with participation by the U.S. Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration, Canadian Council of Motor Transport Administrators, Transport Canada, and the Secretariat of Communications and Transportation (Mexico).






