


Steve Shivak, Executive Director of the ISEE shared some important ISEE updates

It's time to Renew Your Membership

For Safe Excavation and Complex Projects many people believe that by notifying the One Call System of intended excavation they have completed all of their responsibilities with respect to the locating process. This is not the case. Notifying is only the first step, and there are several other important considerations.

Online Ticket Management is a web service application developed by Pennsylvania 811 to provide excavators and designers a way to view their notifications and facility owners responses.

- View current tickets or five years worth of tickets

- Access to tickets entered online or through the call center
- Search for a specific ticket with an assigned serial number or a series of notifications within a specific date range

- See real time responses from facility owners who were notified on a current ticket or search the system for stored responses (maximum of 5 years)



Mine Safety and Health Administration

MSHA Makes Available on Its Website a Proposed Rule to Lower Miners' Exposure to Respirable Crystalline Silica and Improve Respiratory Protection

On June 30, 2023, the Mine Safety and Health Administration (MSHA) made available informally a proposed rule to amend its existing standards to better protect all miners against occupational exposure

540-839-9147 Brzs@tds.net to respirable crystalline silica. Silica is a carcinogen known to cause severe illnesses, including silicosis, non-malignant respiratory disease, lung cancer, and kidney disease.

The proposed rule would significantly improve health protections and promote safe and healthful workplaces for our nation's miners.

MSHA invites the public to review the informal document which is available at MSHA.gov. The notice of proposed rulemaking will soon be published in the Federal Register. MSHA encourages the public to submit any comments online at Regulations.gov once the notice of proposed rulemaking is published in the Federal Register and the public comment period starts.

The hearings will be open for in-person or online participation. More details will be available at the MSHA website after the notice of proposed rulemaking is published in the Federal Register.


In Memory: David M. Baldauf



*Full Membership \$115

Associate Membership \$150

 not otherwise qualified to be a member.
- An Associate Member has all the privileges of a Full Member except they cannot serve as an officer of the society or vote on changes to the Constitution.

Corporate Membership \$595

- Corporate Membership is granted to organizations rather than to individuals. The Corporate Membership entitles the organization to a maximum of three (3) votes and a maximum of three (3) seats at the Annual Membership Meeting.
