SEE Education Foundation Scholarship Now Open

The Society of Explosives Engineers Education Foundation (SEE Foundation) has opened the 2024-2025 scholastic year application process. In 2024, the SEE will award up to \$90,000 USD in scholarships to students pursuing degrees related to the explosives industry.

The SEE Education Foundation is a nonprofit organization created in 1996 to serve the long-term education interests of the explosives industry through the development of education and training materials, championing the inclusion of explosives instruction in engineering curricula and awarding scholarships to eligible students.

The scholarship acceptance period closes on May 6, 2024. We encourage you to forward this information to students interested in applying for the scholarship.

To be eligible, students must be, or plan to be, pursuing a technical, undergraduate, graduate, or doctorate in a field related to the commercial explosives industries. Students will be assessed on academic and professional achievements, industry goals, a personal challenges narrative, and a brief statement of financial need.


The SEE Foundation Scholarship Committee awards scholarships based on information contained in the applications received. In past years, the minimum scholarship awarded was \$500 USD, and top awards have exceeded \$5,000 USD to well-qualified students. Scholarships are open to students from any country and

Spring is Membership Renewal Time


Last year we kicked off our new Springtime Membership Renewal Plan. Our membership renewal traditionally occurred in January, but was adjusted to late spring in 2023.



A Celebration of Life for Judd was held on Sunday, January 14, 2024.



Mine Safety & Health Seminar for Supervisors Planned

Online Ticket Management is a web service application developed by Pennsylvania 811 to provide excavators and designers a way to view their notifications and facility owners responses.

- View current tickets or five years worth of tickets

- Access to tickets entered online or through the call center
- Search for a specific ticket with an assigned serial number or a series of notifications within a specific date range

- See real time responses from facility owners who were notified on a current ticket or search the system for stored responses (maximum of 5 years)
